Agenda 1: To ratify the minutes of last IQAC meeting held on 18th February 2016.

The members approved the resolutions of the meeting held on 18th February, 2016.

Agenda 2: To table the new IQAC initiatives for the approval of committee.

Resolutions:

Director-IQAC proposed the following initiative, after intense discussion in various stake holder meetings.

LMS based Opens source Moodle platform has been introduced to facilitates continues evaluations and other best practices in teaching and learning.

Members present have unanimously accepted the above initiative and Chairman IQAC advisory committee and hon'ble Vice-Chancellor has said that these would be implemented from the next semester onwards effectively, after obtaining necessary approvals from apex body.

Agenda 3: Implementation of LMS system (MOOCS).

Resolutions:

All HODs are insisted for effective use of LMS for attendance, uploading the course material, conduction of quiz tests etc. Further Director IQAC advised the Academic division to train the faculty in this regard.

Agenda 3: Teaching research components at UG and PG level.

Resolutions:

The importance of research taken to class rooms at UG and PG level is deliberated. It is felt that the findings of best researcher and contemporary ideas are possible to percolate down to student level only when the faculty discuss and involve students in their

research. Hence Dean Academics is advised to give a thought to the idea of teaching research component in the UG and PG courses.

Resolutions:

The Director-IQAC appreciated the faculty for effective implementation of LTC and project based labs. Further he advised all HODs to use the simulation tools where ever is applicable for verification of practical and theoretical learning.

The Director-IQAC advised Dean-academics to offer more electives across the University to acquire multi-disciplinary knowledge by the students.

As there is no point raised by the members, the Director, IQAC informed the members to maintain the quality culture in the university.

Further the following activities planned are discussed and deliberated at length.

- 1. Releasing the calendar of activities for the entire academic year in the beginning which helped the departments to plan their activities as per the calendar.
- 2. Introducing the course coordinator system for multi sections has resulted into uniform coverage of syllabus and uniform delivery in multi sections.
- 3. Uploading of course content in e-learning sites has helped the students in better accessing of content.
- 4. Organizing subject based seminars and subject based workshops have helped the faculty and students to enhance their core technical skills.
- 5. Imparting course delivery by foreign faculty has helped the students to have international exposure.

6. Offering academic flexibilities like degree with specialization, interdisciplinary electives etc... have helped the students to have better exposure in their selected

areas.

7. Involving students in various committees has helped the students to share their

thoughts for further improvement of system.

8. Conducting seminars and group discussions on weekly basis has helped the

students to improve their communication skills.

9. Enhancing the student exposure to various industrial processes through guest

lectures, industrial visits, industrial training and practice school.
